Savona Free Library 2015

It is hard to believe that another year has come and gone at the Savona Free Library. 2015 was a year of new beginnings and continuations of old traditions, with a new twist. This last year saw the start of the Friends of the Savona Free Library, Family and Teen Movie Nights, and another Summer Reading Program with a new online reading log and game. There were community collaborations, the Library participated in, Savona at the Park, the Fire Department's Halloween Party, and Christmas Magic in Savona. The Library held most of the events, including the Fire Department's Halloween Party and the Christmas Magic in Savona in the Mary Helen Joint Meeting House. All of the events throughout the year culminated with the Library receiving the 2015 Historic Preservation Award for the rehabilitation of the Mary Helen Joint Meeting House. 2015 has been a busy and eventful year for the Savona Free Library.

A Friends of Savona Free Library group was formed in the end of 2014 and started to meet in 2015. The group consisted of interested people who wanted to help out to plan Library fundraisers, and volunteer to help with Library events. The Savona Free Library could not do the many events and programs for the community without the backing of the Friends of the Savona Free Library. The staff and Board of Trustees wish to Thank all who supported and helped with the Friends of the Savona Library. The Savona Free Library held 62 events during the year. The bulk of the events were children events, but there were many events for family, Young Adults, Adults and the whole community. The Library teamed up with other organizations for community events held at the Mary Helen Joint Meeting House for the first time. The Library joined with the Fire Department to expand the Fire Department's Community Halloween Party to include a haunted house and other additions to the party. Many organizations came together with the Village to hold the "Christmas Magic" in Savona at the Meeting House. Many members of the community came together and had a great time. The Library looks forward to working on more community events and to greater events in 2016.

The collection at Savona Free Library expanded to hold 11943 physical items. Due to the expanding collection, but not expanding space in the current location of the Library, older parts of the collection have been moved to storage at the Mary Helen Joint Meeting House. The collection housed in storage is still available for lending. When requested a staff member can retrieve the item and hold it until the next time the Savona Free Library is open for pick up. Along with the physical collection the digital collection has expanded to hold ebooks, downloadable audio books, streaming videos, Digital data bases, streaming and downloading music, through the service Fregal, and digital magazines through the service Zino. Zino started in the spring of 2015. Come and browse the physical collection or check out the digital collection at our website savonafreelibrary.org.

In December representatives from the Savona Free Library traveled to Albany to be part of the award ceremony for the 2015 Historic Preservation Awards by the NYS Historic Preservation. The Mary Helen Joint Meeting House was one of seven projects picked from thousands of preservation projects across the states for the 2015 Historic Preservation Award. The Mary Helen Joint Meeting House had the smallest budget of all the winners of the award. We may be a small group of communities, but we can all stand just as tall and proud of what we can do when we work together.
