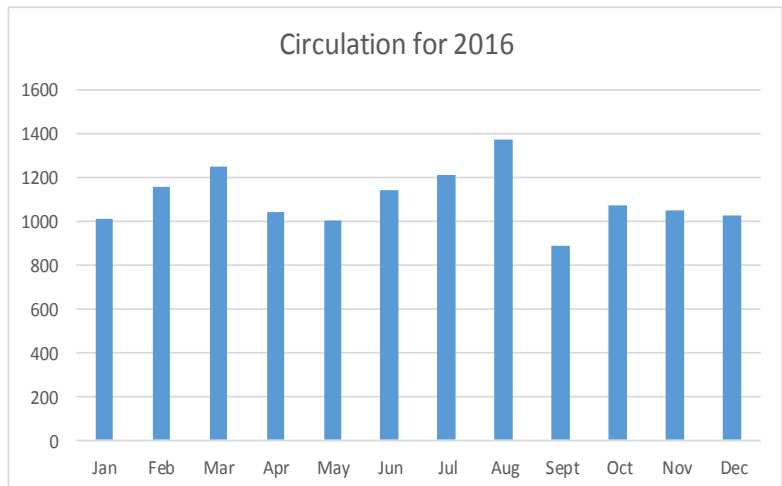

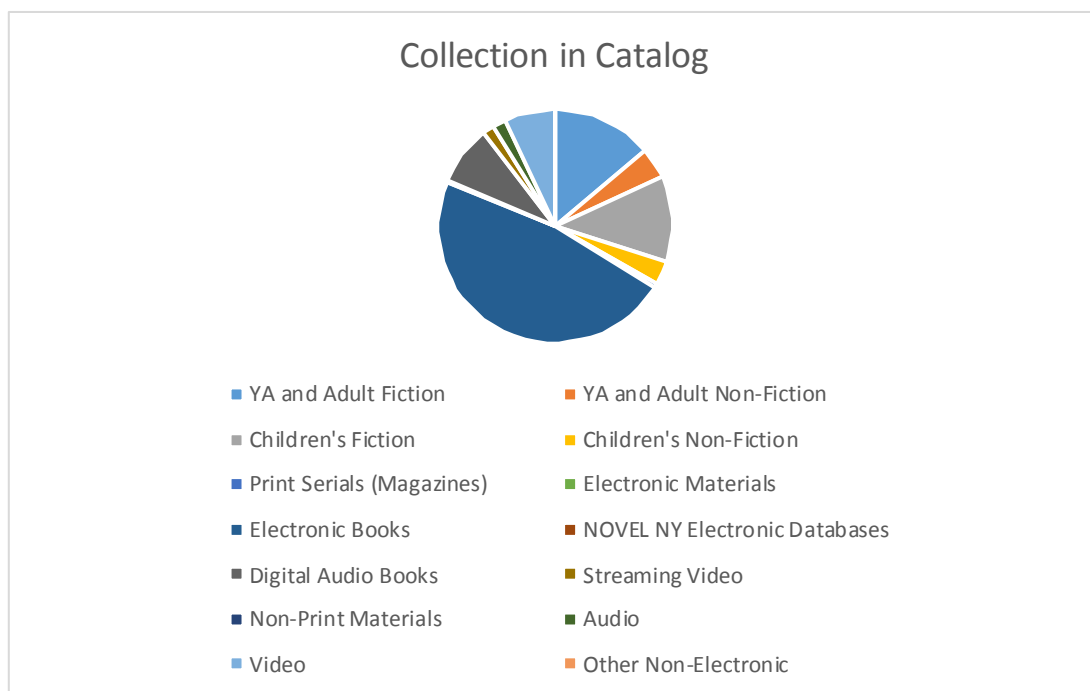

Austin, the unofficial library dog, has been having a great year at the Savona Free Library. He helped in the 2016 Budget Vote, by getting the word out about the voting day. He did his civic duty in voting, just as many residents of the Campbell-Savona School District did. Many went to the High School and voted. The Library budget vote was passed. Soon after the passing of the budget the Library was able to add more operating hours. Due to the new hours our visits have increased to over 3500 visitors. We were able to fit in 58 different programs during the year.

During the 2016 year the library was able to increase the operational hours, increase the amount of visitors and still be able to put on 58 programs.

Austin and his friend Ruby helped in promoting and playing games for the summer reading program “Get in the Game.” They worked at getting people to take up the reading challenge of reading for 20 hours during the six weeks of the Summer Reading Program. Along with winning prizes during the challenge many participated in the events like the Minute to Win It event. Families came together to participate in one minute challenges. All had a great time and won prizes. The Young Adults worked together to write, plan and perform a Murder Mystery event for the adults. The night was great fun, with great food prepared by our own clerk, Rose Fox. Thank you Rose. There were many other events during the summer long programs.

Austin has been nosing around the Mary Helen Joint Meeting House, checking out the changes many volunteers have been working on. Last year the Board of Trustees announced the start of work to temporarily move the library into the Mary Helen Joint Meeting House. The move will be temporary until the new addition can be built to accommodate the growing needs of all our communities. Many bookcases have been built and painted by our volunteers during the last year. Soon the last bookcases (we hope) will be finished and the next phase of moving the library can begin.

The Library has been working with many of the community organizations to bring more events for all in the area communities to enjoy. In Savona we teamed up with the churches, Village, and school to bring Savona in the Park, Music in the Park, and Christmas Magic in Savona. We worked with the Savona Fire Department again this year to put on a great Halloween party for all to start their trick or treating night. Reaching out to the Town of Campbell the library was able to hold a Resume Workshop at the town hall for anyone needing help with employment searches. We are always looking to help build better community events and more events.

In the coming year the Savona Free Library looks forward to continuing to take additional steps to better serve all of the communities. We will be continuing to work toward moving the Library temporarily into the Mary Helen Joint Meeting House. We are always looking for more partners to work to expand our services and put on great community events. Currently we are starting to plan for the next Summer Reading Program Build a Better World.
